- 1. Call to Order: 6:31pm
- 2. Public Comment: Bea Dufort. Bea expressed congratulations to Susan for all her work on behalf of the library. She would like to know what she can do to help the library, either fundraising or otherwise. Susan suggested she join the development council, help with the fundraising gala, post/share library events on social media. The board will go through their wishlists and come up with a specific project for Bea to assist with.
- 3. Director's Report: see attached. Library partially flooded over the weekend, but the damage was remediated by Mammoth Restoration. Insurance covers up to \$50K with the exception of a \$1,000 deductible. Jean suggested a water alarm in case something like this happens again. Greg will look into it. There is also a problem with the outside lights they will not turn off. Electricians have been called to address the issue. Gazebo has been installed and looks great. The storywalk has been disrupted due to the construction of the new dog park. Acme designated RKL as non-profit of the month: every sale of the reusable bags will generate \$1 donation to the library. Susan discussed holding the anniversary gala at II Granaio, selling tickets for \$100/person. It was suggested to try and get wine or champaign donated. Committee will decide the details of the event.
- 4. Minutes: motioned, seconded, approved.
- 5. Treasurer's Report: Jen created a spreadsheet for projected budgeting. The board motioned, seconded, and approved her spreadsheet.
- DCL meetings: No report. 12/5 in Media, Brian Doherty will attend. Derek attended a DCL policy meeting. He reported that the Delco library system is still rolling out google chrome to all libraries. They will also be using truetext messaging for book renewals. Minors need a library card to access library computers.
